A four-hour boat cruise from the city center to the Ljubljana Marshes Nature Park

Once upon a time, there was a big lake just south of Ljubljana that centuries later turned into a marshland. In this marshland they found the oldest wooden wheel in the world. Though we can't promise you to find a Green Dragon there, the tour will take us into Ljubljana's historical southern quarters, where we will embark on a boat and take a tour into the marshes that lie just on the outskirts of the capital. This breathtaking boat tour will let you experience the unique wildlife of the nature park, the rich history of a 6000 years old Pile Dwelling culture, the stories of the goddess Eurna, the history of a once prosperous river trade and many other surprises! On top of that we will stop for a pic-nic on the riverbanks of Ljubljana.

## CYCLE THE WIRE AND BEYOND - LJUBLJANA OFF THE BEATEN TRACK

Five-hour cycling trip through the city and its natural surroundings

What is now a circular green path around Ljubljana, was during World War 2 a fence set by the Italian fascists in order to separate the city from its surroundings and suppress the rebellion of the people. The plan was not successful and Ljubljana later received the title of a "Hero City". We will cycle a part of the former fence where we will encounter optimistic residential developments of the socialist times, a neo-classicist cemetery built by the world-famous architect Jože Plečnik, former youth-run railways, amazing sculptures, new urban developments, pristine sources of drinking water, wild riverbanks and as many green areas as you can imagine. In Ljubljana, the European Green Capital of 2016, nature is always just around the corner.

Join us for a first hand experience of the history of the city, its people and the nature that surrounds it all. All this in less than a day! And don't worry, the route is almost 100% flat.
